ICP Statement following August 26, 2016 District Court Decision in *ICP v. TDHCA*

As ICP and our attorneys review the District Court's August 26, 2016 decision in *ICP v. TDHCA* and consider our next steps, we will continue our efforts to ensure low income families of color are able to exercise their fair housing rights and have access to housing outside of high poverty, under-resourced, segregated areas of the Dallas Metroplex. Since ICP first filed the case against TDHCA in 2008, a growing supply of low income housing tax credit units have been built and now provide a limited number of families of color with access to neighborhoods free from distress and segregation. ICP intends to use all available tools to pursue its mission and efforts, including the now settled Fair Housing Disparate Impact approach.
